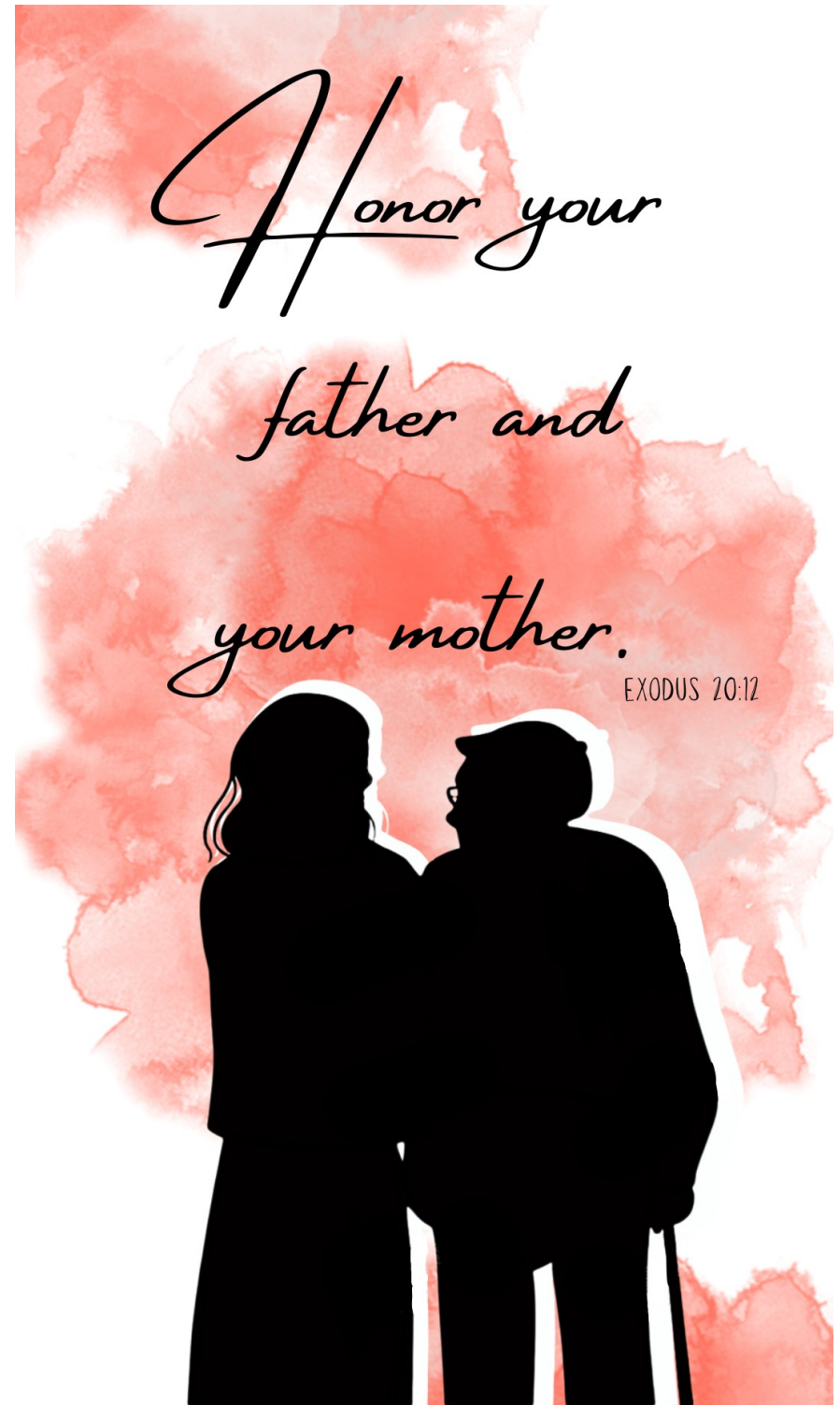
We have received a Thank You card from Doris Roberts for the prayers, cards, and gift during her illness.
